The Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCP) was established in 1980 as Malaysia's commitment to South-South Cooperation through the sharing of Malaysia's development experiences and expertise with other developing countries.

MTCP is premised on the principle that the development of a country is dependent on the quality of its human capital and resources. MTCP emphasises on human resources development mainly through training and capacity-building courses including short-term courses at Malaysian public and private training institutions, and fully funded scholarship at Malaysian public universities.

Annually, Malaysia offered more than 65 technical training and capacity-building programmes under the MTCP, which have benefited more than 37,000 participants from 144 countries.

ACADEMIC QUALIFICATION

Second Class Upper (Honours) / **CGPA 3.50** at undergraduate level.

English language requirements:

- IELTS overall score of **6.0** and above; or
- TOEFL iBT total score of **60** and above; or
- Obtained a previous degree(s) with English used as the medium of instruction.

SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS

This Scholarship covers tuition fees and other allowances worth **RM3,500 per month**.
